

ADDENDUM Tracking

1 BASIC MODE OF OPERATION

We use a cell phone based GPS tracking system to provide additional information for all participants during the ORC Worlds 2023.

[DP] The use of this system is mandatory.

2 DISPLAY

The links to the tracking pages (to view the data) will be published on the event website.

3 OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS

3.1 POWERING ON...

3.1.1 Press the power button for 6 seconds through plastic.

- Test powering on and off at any time before the race. It must be visible. Save battery.
- The tracker should be powered on Monday, August 7 morning as early as you wish.
- Deadline for power-on is on Monday, August 7 morning at 9:00 hrs

3.1.2 Check that your boat is visible online: www.sportrec.eu/gps/orc-worlds-org

3.1.3 It is recommended to restart (power off, power on again) on Wednesday, August 9 morning. (This will help the tracker to reconfigure to the inshore race work mode).

3.1.4 Do not switch off the tracker during the week!

If the tracker works and charges ok, keep it running from the first till the last day.

3.2 LED LIGHTS

GPS LED is shining during the inshore races.

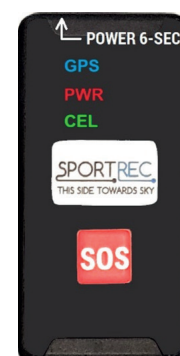
During the offshore race, it may be shining, blinking or off.

PWR LED is:

- Dark = working on battery
- Blinking slowly = battery nearly empty
- Blinking fast = charging
- Shining = fully charged

CEL LED must be blinking slowly with 3-sec intervals.

If blinking fast with 1-sec intervals RESTART from power button!



4 PENALTIES FOR INCORRECT OPERATION

[DP] For incorrect operation of the tracking system the Jury can award a penalty.

This includes the (not-)charging of batteries.

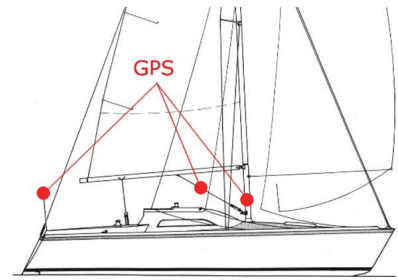
6 FIXING-INSTRUCTIONS ON BOARD

Use the following instructions to place the GPS TRACKER

1. Outside
2. As high as possible – for example on light pole, on mast bottom or boom vang
3. LED lights up toward the sky

The Race office may distribute mini-grip gap.

In case of rough weather place the tracker inside the mini-grip bag.



7 LOADING

- 7.1 Remove plastic protection after the offshore race.
- 7.2 Charge the tracker between race days.
- 7.3 When the red power LED is shining continuously = the battery is full.
- 7.4 Do not charge the tracker during racing, unless the battery is very low (may cause problems).
- 7.5 Battery % can be seen by opening the participant list of the org tracking page www.sportrec.eu/gps/orc-worlds-org.
- 7.6 [DP] You must check daily the battery %. If the % is below 50 % you must charge the GPS tracker after the last race of the day.

8 RETURNING

[DP] Return the tracker to the race office immediately after finishing the last race.

9 LIABILITY IN CASE OF LOSS

If the tracker is lost, the compensation fee is € 200,-
